Contribution During COVID-19 Pandemic

1. As Vice-Chancellor facilitated the operationalization of one of the first Nodal Laboratory (ICMR Project) in Uttar Pradesh for “free of cost” testing of Covid-19 virus at JNMC Hospital, AMU. This laboratory initially performed tests of patients from whole of western UP including Agra, Noida, Greater Noida, Ghaziabad, Hathras, Mathura, Badaun, Moradabad, Rampur, Etah etc. University purchased one new RT-PCR Machine and procured another from UP Government to augment the testing capacity. Virology Lab is having testing capacity of 2000 RT-PCR tests per day.
2. 100 bed Isolation ward operationalized for Covid-19 patients in JNMC Hospital with provision of ventilators etc. (Equivalent to Level 3 COVID-19 Facility). Patients of Aligarh and adjoining districts such as Etah, Hathras, Kasganj, Mathura etc. are being treated.
3. Co-Principal Investigator of Phase III Trial of COVID-19 Vaccine “COVAXIN” (Sponsored by ICMR and Bharat Biotech). Trial performed on 1000 volunteers.
